- (5) **Funerals should be conducted in accordance with the safety guidance in "Nothing can Separate us from the Love of God" with a maximum of 25 mourners present.**
- (6) **The Sacrament of Marriage should be celebrated in accordance with the safety guidance in "Nothing can Separate us from the Love of God" with a maximum of 25 guests present.**
- (7) **All gatherings for parish related activities are to be moved on-line.**
- (8) **It is advisable that Parish News Letters continue.**
- (9) **An appropriate means for people to return their donation envelopes will be made available locally. Parishioners may also wish to donate to their parish using the online donation facility on the Clonfert Diocesan Website.**
